



# Weekly Wakeups

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## Pastry Chef Makes Bread

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**Summary:** A chef (fun to create a character with an accent) comes into the bakery to make bread rolls out of the sleeping campers/parents.

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**Number of staff required:** 1 (the more the merrier)

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**Props/Materials/Costumes:** \*These are suggestions. Use whatever you have available to you in your home.

- Flour (or shredded paper)
  - Chef (ish) costume.
  - Anything else that could be used as a bread ingredient – rosemary, seasonings, etc
  - Rolling pin (pool noodle)
  - Apron – to hold your supplies
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### Prep:

Gather your supplies so they are easily accessible. Perhaps in your apron.

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## Execution:

- Enter the bedroom as if you have just entered your bakery to begin the day's work.
- Mumble, sing, chat to yourself as you go about making your breads (accents are always fun). It's fun to comment on your 'dough'.
- Begin with adding toppings to your bread – sprinkling them on each camper describing the flavor of the bread they will become.
- Start by kneading the dough, which means "massage" the feet of the sleepers in their sleeping bag/blankets.
- Now you start to roll out the dough with your pool noodle or rolling pin.
- Again, describing your actions in your funny accents adds to the hilarity.
- Tell them that you are now going to bake the bread.
- If comfortable or capable, pick up each camper or gently drag them out of bed and place them (as much as they are comfortable) under their beds to be baked. **Or** Tell them that you are now going to bake the pizza.
- Exit the cabin.
- Come back and pull them out of the oven -> pull (again gently) them from their beds.



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
