

2021 Camper Transportation Information: Buses, Cars, and Planes!

This document is designed to inform you of your camper's options for transportation to and from camp and ask for an alternate pick up person. Campers can either arrive by private vehicle, Camp Augusta chartered buses or by plane.

Please confirm that you have read this document by typing your name on the Parent Packet Signatures form. You will be asked to write the name of the person picking up your child at the bus stop or at camp (if travelling by personal vehicle).

Bus Transportation

2021 COVID Update: Due to our inability to fully quarantine each camper before their arrival to camp, **we will not be offering a bus TO Camp at this time.** We will be monitoring the COVID situation and adjusting our plans as we move closer to the summer. If we are able to add the bus TO camp we will be in touch via email. Currently we are only offering a bus FROM camp on the final day as all of our campers will have been in the same bubble/pod by the time they leave Camp.

There is a **\$65 fee, each way**, for the bus service. Reservations are required in advance so the appropriate number of buses can be booked. ***Please note that we cannot offer a refund for the bus with less than 10 days notice.***

- The bus **will drop off campers** at Piedmont Park across the street from Wells Fargo Bank at **12 noon on June 19th, July 3rd, July 17th, July 31st, August 7th, and August 14th**. Please arrive 15 minutes early to greet your camper, and please make SURE to sign them out (unless you have signed the waiver allowing them off the bus without a parent or guardian signature) with the bus staff. ***The name of the person picking up your child must match the name on the online form.*** Please call us immediately if this name changes after the form has been submitted. If you do not want to have to wait and sign your camper(s) out please designate this on the online form. Please check in with the camp staff at the bus regarding any store money refunds or medications you would expect your camper to have. The online form also has a question regarding this.
- If you have a Wilderness Trip camper departing Camp on a day that does not align with a Summer Camp session bus trip, alternate transportation must be arranged by you.

The check in process can take some time to make sure we have everything we need for every camper. You can help speed this process up by sending in your store money in advance, arriving with a completed "Medical Update Form" which will be emailed to you the week before, and having any medications stored in their original containers and then inside a ziplock bag with your campers name and cabin on it.

Bus Rules

In order to provide a safe and enjoyable bus trip for campers, counselors, and the bus driver, please review the following rules with your camper.

- All campers must stay on the door side of the bus during loading & unloading.
- All campers must remain seated and facing forward at all times
- The noise level should not exceed the comfort level of the bus driver.
- No electronics (iPods, game boys, etc.), food, or candy.

Car Transportation

Campers coming to camp by car should arrive between 2 and 3:00 pm on the first day of the session (Sunday). Please do not arrive before 2:00 pm as our staff will be in a meeting and unable to greet you. Campers should be picked up between 9 and 9:30 am on the final day of the session (Saturday).

Depending on COVID restrictions at the time we may be limiting carpooling to direct family and cabin mates. We will release updated arrival information before the summer begins.

Plane Transportation/Airport pick-up

If your camper will be arriving by plane please contact the office elves before purchasing tickets for our COVID protocols. Masks will be required for all portions of traveling to Camp including the car ride from the airport to Camp.

Airport pick-ups are available from **Sacramento airport** on the first and last day of each Resident Camp session. There is a \$65 fee, each way, for this service. Campers arriving by plane will be picked up by a smiling Camp Augusta staff member. Airport pick-ups from San Francisco and other local airports **MAY** be available, but only if adequate staff and camp vehicles are available. ***Please contact us before booking San Francisco flights as we need to ensure adequate staffing and vehicle availability.***

Campers can arrive at Sacramento Airport on flights that **land between 11:30-1:30pm**, on the first day of camp (Sunday) and depart from Sacramento Airport on flights **departing between 11:00am-1:00pm** on their last day of camp (Saturday). Please heed these times when booking; it makes for a MUCH easier pick-up/drop-off process for camp staff and campers. **If for some reason flights during these time periods are not available to you please contact the office elves as soon as possible to see what other options we may have.**

Please confirm they have these before leaving the bus area. If they do not and they should, please check in with one of the Camp Augusta staff.

How do we get to the Bus Pick-up/Drop-off area?

1. From 580 East, exit on Oakland/Harrison Ave. and stay in the left lane.
2. At the stoplight, turn left under the freeway and pass through the next light if it is green.
3. Continue up the hill and merge into the center lane before the stop sign.
4. Proceed down the hill and cross Grand Ave.
5. Continue up the hill until you reach Hillside Ave. Turn right there.
6. Continue around the left-sweeping corner by the park.
7. Park anywhere along Magnolia Avenue.
