2023 Camper Transportation Information: Buses, Cars, and Planes!

Campers can either arrive by private vehicle, by plane, or by Camp Augusta chartered buses.

Please confirm that you have read this document by digitally signing the <u>Parent Packet Signatures</u> form. You will also be asked the name of the person picking up your child at the bus stop or at camp (if travelling by personal vehicle).

Important 2023 COVID BUS Transportation Information:

We are planning to provide a bus both TO and FROM camp this summer. However, we do reserve the right to cancel our buses if the circumstance arises.

There is a \$75 fee, <u>each way</u>, for the bus service. Reservations are required in advance so the appropriate number of buses can be booked. *Please note that we cannot offer a refund for the bus with less than 10 days notice.*

If you chose to add the bus TO or FROM Camp after June 1st you will be required to pay by credit card at the time.

- **Bus TO Camp info:** (confirmed)
- The <u>bus will pick up campers</u> at Piedmont Park across the street from Wells Fargo Bank. Dates: Sundays June 11th, June 18th, June 25th, July 9th, July 23rd, and August 6th.
- The bus leaves at 12:00 (Noon). **Please be prepared to arrive by 10:40 AM**. Parents who miss the bus will be responsible for transporting their camper to camp.
- Campers will be antigen tested before getting on the bus.
- Please make sure your camper has already eaten lunch and gone to the bathroom before boarding the bus. You might consider bringing a lunch for them to eat while checking in and waiting to board the bus.
- Please bring a completed Medical Update Form (will be emailed to you one week before your session)
- Please have any/ALL **medications** stored in their **original containers** inside a ziplock bag labeled with your camper's name and cabin.
- Please MAIL in STORE money in advance.
- **Bus FROM Camp info:** (confirmed))
- The **bus will drop off campers** at Piedmont Park across the street from Wells Fargo Bank at **12 noon**
- Please arrive 15 minutes early to greet your camper, and please make SURE to sign them out (unless you have signed the waiver allowing them off the bus without a parent or guardian signature) with the bus staff.
- The name of the person picking up your child must match the name on the online form. Please call us immediately if this name changes after the form has been submitted. If you do not want to have to wait and sign your camper(s) out of the bus please designate this on the online form within your parent packet. Please check in with the camp staff at the bus regarding any store money refunds or medications you would expect your camper to have.
- If you have a Wilderness Trip camper departing Camp on a day that does not align with a Summer Camp session bus trip, alternate transportation must be arranged by you.

Bus Rules

To provide a safe and enjoyable bus trip for ALL, please review the following rules with your camper...

- All campers must stay on the door side of the bus during loading & unloading.
- All campers must remain seated and facing forward at all times
- The noise level should not exceed the comfort level of the bus driver.
- No electronics (iPods, game boys, etc.), food, or candy will be allowed.

Car – Private Vehicle Transportation

- **Campers coming to camp by car should arrive between 2 and 3:00 pm on the first day of the session (Sunday).**
 - o For Arrival Please do not arrive before 2:00 pm as our staff will be in a meeting and unable to greet you.
 - For Departure Campers should be picked up between 9 and 9:30 am on the final day of the session (Saturday). If we update this arrival time due to our COVID protocols, we will be in touch.


Plane Transportation/Airport pick-up

Airport pick-ups are available from <u>Sacramento airport</u> on the first and last day of each Resident Camp session. There is a \$75 fee, each way, for this service. Campers arriving by plane will be picked up by a smiling Camp Augusta staff member.

Campers can arrive at Sacramento Airport on flights that land between 12-1:30pm, on the first day of camp (Sunday) and depart from Sacramento Airport on flights departing between 11:00am-1:00pm on their last day of camp (Saturday). Please heed these times when booking; it makes for a MUCH easier pick-up/drop-off process for camp staff and campers. If for some reason flights during these time periods are not available to you please contact the office elves as soon as possible to see what other options we may have.

 The bus leaves Piedmont for camp at 12:00 pm sharp. Please arrive with your camper 1 hour prior to this time. The bus ride is approximately 3 hours long. Parents who miss the bus will be responsible for transporting their camper to camp. Please have your camper EAT LUNCH BEFORE getting on the bus. You might consider bringing a lunch to eat while checking in and waiting for the bus to leave. All forms and payment must be received before your child Please send your store money in advance and arrive with a completed "Medical Update Form" to help speed the process up. 	 The bus leaves Camp for Piedmont at 9:00am. Expected arrival in Piedmont is at 12:00 noon depending on traffic. When the bus arrives, campers will be released one at a time to the adult designated on the transportation form (unless you choose to waive this procedure). As they get off the bus you will be asked to sign your name, confirming you picked them up. If applicable, store money refunds and medications will be given to your child just prior to them getting off the bus. Please confirm they have these before leaving the bus area. If they do not and they should, please check in with one of the Camp Augusta

Medications – Paperwork – Bathroom

On Sunday when you are dropping off your camper(s), please have any medication (in ORIGINAL containers) in a Ziploc bag with your campers name and cabin written on it ready to turn in to camp staff. Make sure all of your paperwork has been turned in, including the "Medical Update Form" that is required to be submitted at check in.

Please have your camper go to the bathroom prior to boarding the bus. There will be a bathroom on the bus; however, these bathrooms aren't always the most enjoyable. \odot

How do we get to the Bus Pick-up/Drop-off area?

- 1. From 580 East, exit on Oakland/Harrison Ave. and stay in the left lane.
- 2. At the stoplight, turn left under the freeway and pass through the next light if it is green.
- 3. Continue up the hill and merge into the center lane before the stop sign.
- 4. Proceed down the hill and cross Grand Ave.
- 5. Continue up the hill until you reach Hillside Ave. Turn right there.
- 6. Continue around the left-sweeping corner by the park.
- 7. Park anywhere along Magnolia Avenue.
