

Trip Insurance... What do I need to Know?

Trip Interruption & Cancel For Any Reason (CFAR)
See below to learn the differences...

Basic Trip Insurance IS helpful if...

You need to cancel due to sickness (including COVID), injury, or death of an immediate family member prior to arrival at camp, this can be up until the start of the program. ✓

Trip Interruption Insurance IS helpful if...

Unexpected events like sickness (including COVID) or injury require your child to leave camp early. ✓

Cancel For Any Reason (CFAR) IS helpful if...

You read that it's going to be 100 degrees the weekend of your family camp and you decide it's too hot for your family.

A family emergency means your camper cannot attend and camp is unable to fill their spot.

You read our emails letting you know the AQI is going to be VERY bad during your session and you don't feel comfortable attending or having your camper attend.

With any of these circumstance, you **MUST purchase a plan with CFAR and cancel at least TWO days prior** to the start of your program! ✓

How Much Does It Cost?

Price can vary be between \$100-\$300 depending on the company and type of coverage you decide to buy.

Payment Deadline:

You **MUST** purchase the trip coverage plan within **14 days** of your first payment/initial deposit to be eligible for a plan with **CFAR**.

This can vary depending on the company so be sure to do your research early!

Trip Insurance is NOT helpful if...

Augusta cancels the session/family camp. This can be for:

Bad AQI or a non-mandatory fire evacuation
A COVID or other significant disease outbreak
Camp cancelling for a non-Natural Disaster

Essentially, most insurances will not cover if Augusta cancels camp.

Augusta updates families with weather and AQI predictions. If you have purchased a plan with **CFAR**, you are eligible to submit a claim as long as it's **TWO days PRIOR** to the start of the program & Augusta has not yet cancelled. ✗
